The Virginia Victim Assistance Network seeks to hire Mental Health Clinicians to lead Homicide Survivor Support Groups:

The Virginia Victim Assistance Network seeks licensed mental health clinicians with experience in grief and trauma to lead Homicide Survivor Support Groups for eight months or longer.

This is a part-time, contracted position.

The clinician will be asked to lead a meeting once a month for one hour at \$125 hour and will also be paid \$100 for two planning hours a month. Mileage is reimbursable.

Position requires a 3 to 5 hour Trauma Informed Care Training provided by VVAN at no cost to the clinician.

Clinicians will work closely with the Homicide Support Group Coordinator to coordinate, plan, implement and evaluate the Support Groups.

Groups will consist of adults only, and group sizes will be manageable (5-15 survivors).

This is an opportunity to make a huge difference in the lives of those experiencing the loss of a loved one due to violence.

Bi-lingual therapists are in demand in certain locales.

We are partnering with your local Victim/Witness office.
